Massive Economic Impacts.



For the US alone, an additional **annual cost of \$160 million** for deliveries that depend on personal knowledge.


Configuring the what3words Locator for ArcGIS for Desktop

Getting Started

1. Sign up for a what3words account at developer.what3words.com/.
2. Once you've signed up and verified your account, just send an email to arcgis@what3words.com to request that your API key is enabled for ArcGIS and we'll set you up for a 14 day free trial
3. Once your API key is enabled, we'll email you your what3words locator credentials; the username will be your API key and you'll also be notified of your locator password

Add the what3words Locator to ArcMap

1. If the Geocoding toolbar is not active within ArcMap, you'll need to enable this. From the *Customize* menu, select *Toolbars* and click on *Geocoding*.


