ArcGIS Desktop

Install

If other ArcGIS® products are installed on your machine, they must be uninstalled before proceeding with the ArcGIS Desktop Evaluation Edition setup.

- * Close all applications on your computer.
- * Insert ArcGIS Desktop Evaluation Edition CD 1.
- * Select Install ArcGIS Desktop and ArcGIS Desktop Extensions Evaluation.
- * Click Install.
- * Follow the installation instructions.
Note: You must select the Complete or Custom installation type to install the ArcGIS Desktop extensions.

Register

- * Select Register Now.

Note: To register at a later time, click Exit. When you want to register, navigate to Start > Programs > ArcGIS > Desktop Administrator, select the Register Single Use and Extensions folder, and click Register Now.

Automatic Registration

This is the recommended method and requires the computer to be connected to the Internet.

- * Click I have installed ArcView/ArcEditor and need to register the software.
- * Click Register now using the Internet.
- * Follow the installation instructions.

Note: If you have already registered and received an authorization file in the *.esu9 format, select I have received an authorization file from ESRI and am now ready to finish the registration process.

Manual Registration

Use this method if the computer you are using does not have an Internet connection.

- * Select Register by e-mail or Fax or mail your registration. Alternatively, from another machine that has an Internet connection, browse to service.esri.com, select the Product Registration link, and follow the instructions.
- * You will receive an authorization file in a *.esu9 format. Save this file to your machine.
- * Open the Registration Wizard from the Desktop Administrator and choose I have received an authorization file from ESRI and am now ready to finish the registration process.
- * Browse to the saved authorization file to complete the registration.

- * Insert ArcGIS Desktop Evaluation Edition CD 3.
- * Select Install Tutorial Data.
Note: The default installation location for the tutorial data is C:\arcgis\ArcTutor.
- * Follow the installation instructions.
Note: You must select the Complete or Custom installation type to install tutorial data for the ArcGIS Desktop extensions.
