



Document Updated: Exhibit 1 Scope of Use (E300)

Date of Update Implementation: October 10, 2013

Overview: The updated Exhibit 1, Scope of Use (E300) has been updated to reflect minor changes due to clarification of definitions, updated Product names, new Products and update restrictions to the use of ArcGIS Online Data and Online Services.

Changes:

- Addendum 1; Section 1- Definitions

What: Concurrent Use License and Deployment Server License Definitions (pg. 1 of 16)

Why: Definitions were updated to clarify meaning.

"Concurrent Use License" means a license to install and use the Product on computer(s) on a network, but the number of simultaneous users may not exceed the number of licenses acquired. ~~including.~~ A Concurrent Use License includes the right to run passive failover instances of Concurrent Use License management software in a separate operating system environment for temporary failover support.

"Deployment Server License" means a full use license that authorizes Licensee to install and use the Software for ~~the following purposes: building and testing Value-Added Applications; conducting user acceptance testing, performance testing, and load testing of other third party software; staging new commercial data updates; training activities; and all other~~ all uses permitted in the License Agreement and as described in the Documentation.

- Addendum 1; Section 2- Terms of Use for Specific Software Table and Footnotes

What: In the table, Server Products: Cloud Bundle renamed to read Virtual Cloud Infrastructure. All references within the E300 have been updated to reflect this change. (pg. 2 of 16)

Why: Updated to correct Product name.

What: In the table, Developer Tools: ArcGIS Runtime SDK's (pg. 2 of 16)

Why: Added new ArcGIS Runtime SDK's made available at version 10.2

- ArcGIS Runtime SDK for ~~Android, iOS, Java, Mac OS X, Microsoft .NET Framework (Windows [desktop]), Windows Phone, Windows Store, Qt, Mobile, Mac OS X, or Android~~ (16; 19; Addendum 2, Note 1)



- ArcGIS Runtime ~~SDK~~ **Standard Level** for ~~WPF~~ Android, iOS, Java, Mac OS X, Microsoft .NET Framework (Windows [desktop], Windows Phone, Windows Store), Qt (~~16;19;~~), or

What: Developer Tools: ArcGIS Web Mapping (pg. 2 of 16)

Why: Removed ArcGIS API for WPF. WPF capabilities have been moved to the ArcGIS Runtime SDK Suite.

- ArcGIS Web Mapping (including ArcGIS API for JavaScript/HTML5, ArcGIS API for Flex, ArcGIS API for Microsoft Silverlight, ~~ArcGIS API for WPF~~) (15; 16; 64; 66; Addendum 2, Note 1)

What: Footnote 1: Updated ArcGIS Online Organization Account to ArcGIS Online for Organizations Account. All references within the E300 have now been changed to reflect this name change. (pg. 3 of 16)

Why: Correction made to product name.

- Licensee may use the Software, Data, and Online Services included in ArcGIS for Transportation Analytics solely for direct support of fleet operations. No other use of ArcGIS for Transportation Analytics or the individual components that are part of ArcGIS for Transportation Analytics is permitted. This restriction does not apply to the ArcGIS Online ~~Organization Account~~ for Organizations account included with ArcGIS for Transportation Analytics. The ArcGIS Online ~~Organization Account~~ for Organizations account can be used for any purpose subject to the terms of this License Agreement

- Addendum 2; Section 2 (Specific Terms of Use for Data) Table & Footnotes

What: In the table, changed name of Navteq to HERE. All references to Navteq have been changed to HERE, except in the links. (pg. 5 of 16)

Why: Due to global change of Navteq, we are required to update documents to their new name.

What: In the table, changed name of Map Studio to Esri Map Studio (pg. 5 of 16)

Why: Correction to product name



What: Footnote 1: ArcGIS Online Data (pg. 5 of 16)

Why: Services including basemaps requires an ArcGIS Online Account. Users should refer to their plan type for Plan use restrictions.

- *ArcGIS Online Data: Software and Online Services that reference this note enable access to ArcGIS Online Data. ArcGIS Online Data is provided for use solely in conjunction with Licensee's authorized use of Esri Software and Online Services. Licensee may provide third parties with access to Use of ArcGIS Online Data that is accessible through Licensee's Value-Added Application(s) non-fee-based ArcGIS Online accounts may be subject to Addendum 3 usage limits.*
- Addendum 3: Section 2 (Terms of Use for Specific Online Services) Table & Footnotes

What: Added 'Esri' in front of Business Analyst Online, Redistricting Online and MapStudio. (pg. 13 of 16)

Why: Correction to product name.

What: Removed subsections (i) and (ii) from Footnote 1(a). (pg. 13 of 16)

Why: Esri removed the requirement that the user purchased an ArcGIS Online Subscription in order to use non Esri developer tools to build applications that use Esri's Online Services. Users of an ArcGIS Online Plan may still use the developer tools to build applications that consume online services, but there is still the requirement to acknowledge that the application is using Online Services and Users may not remove any attribution associated with the use of Online Services.

- Licensee may use Licensee's Esri Online Services account to build a Value-Added Application(s) using for Licensee's internal use.
 - i. ~~ArcGIS Online Development Tools and Services enabled through Licensee's ArcGIS Online Plan account for Licensee's internal use; or~~
 - ii. ~~Third-party development tools but only for development and testing or for Value-Added Application(s) used only in conjunction with a paid Esri Online Services account.~~
