This session will talk about re-using sharing your work using templates.

- Simple templates can give you a head start for common patterns or layouts
- Templates are a great way to share complex apps for others to use

A <u>solution</u> is an item type in ArcGIS Online and Enterprise.

Solutions comes in two states – template and deployed.

A template solution contains a set of items that can be activated again and again.

- Are a snapshot of live items at a specific point in time
- Include item details, data, thumbnails, and other item resources that are conferred on activation
- Store dependencies between items
- Use variables for dynamic activation
  - Can be used to reference activated item, organization/portal information, extent, and more
  - Ex: {{solution.title}}

- Currently support over 40 item types, including
  - Sites and Pages
  - Hosted Feature Services and Views
  - Web Maps
  - Experience Builder and Web Applications, Dashboards, StoryMaps
  - Survey123 Forms, Workforce Projects, QuickCapture Projects
  - Python Notebooks
  - Download Item Types (Pro Project Packages, Zip Files, Word Documents, PDFs, Images, CSVs, etc.)
  - Groups

An <u>initiative template</u> is a package of *solutions* that work to achieve a specific goal.

- Can contain one or many solutions
- When activating an initiative template, the solution that contains a site (and other items which support the site) will be deployed. This is called the *included* solution.
- Other solutions will be recommended and can be activated by users as they choose and more than once

A deployed <u>solution</u> provides links to created items upon activation and stores the dependencies between items.

### **Cloning v. Templating in Hub**

Compared to cloning, templating provides more control


- Respects static and dynamic content
- Can be activated modularly
- Initiative templates and solutions can be shared to others via groups
- Is useful for things you'd like to recreate more than once
