# Removal of ArcMap-based runtime from ArcGIS Enterprise support

It's not goodbye, but thank you...

ArcGIS Enterprise contains  
two internal runtimes.

One runtime for services  
to be published **from ArcMap**.

One runtime for services  
to be published **from ArcGIS Pro**.

This means twice the work!



Starting with the  
ArcGIS 10.9.x  
releases...

Both runtimes will  
still be included.

Tooling will switch  
compatible services  
from ArcMap runtime  
to ArcGIS Pro runtime.

Services that aren't  
compatible will need to  
be republished.



Starting with the  
ArcGIS 2022  
releases...

Only the  
ArcGIS Pro runtime  
will be included.

It will no longer  
be possible  
to publish or run  
services from ArcMap.

Some ArcMap-based  
services will no longer  
run.


