

The tool utilizes publicly available data from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), National Health Care Statistics (NHCS), the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), WONDER, as well as HHS-CDC analysis using these and other publicly available data.
