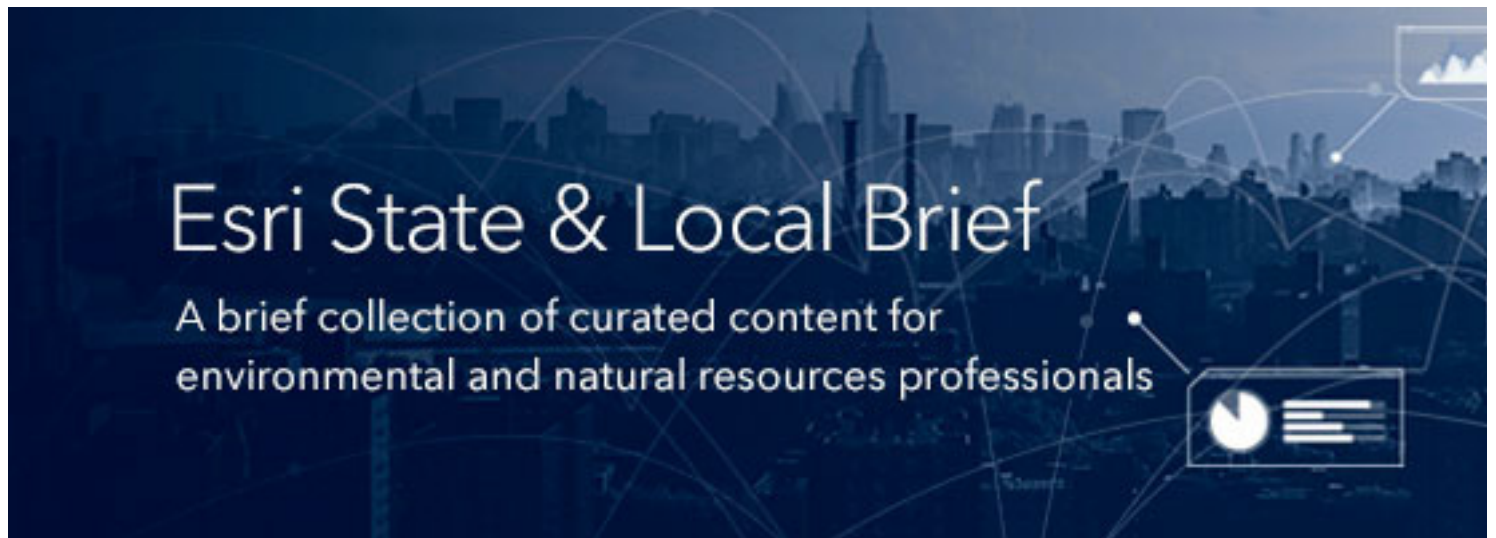

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How Cape Cod Is Saving Its Shoreline from the Effects of Climate Change

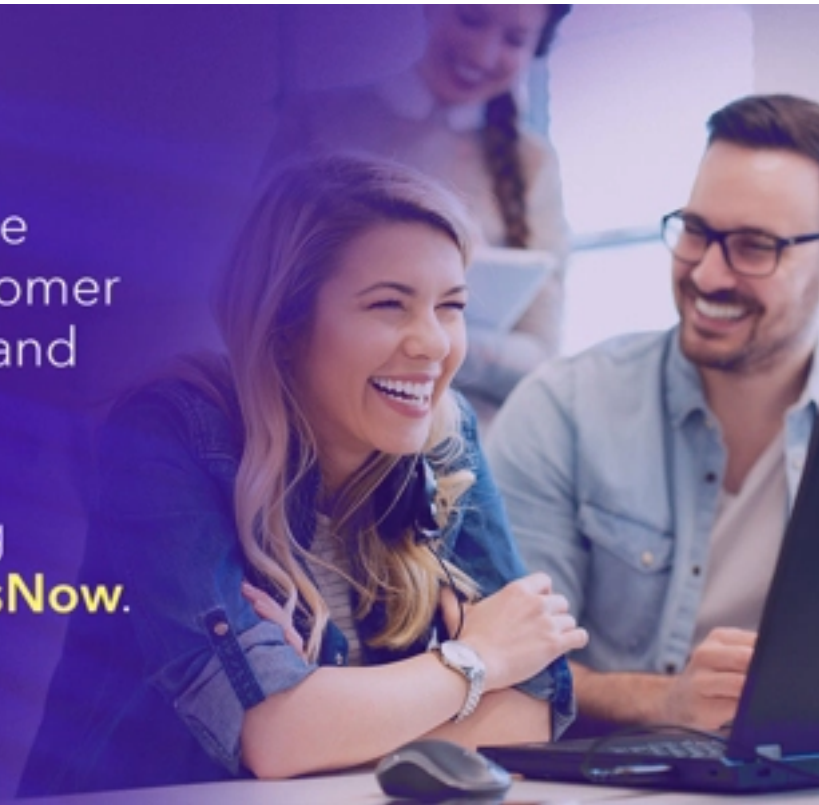


In response to shore erosion, Cape Cod Commission uses geodesign for obtaining data and making evaluations and implementing plans to enhance resilience.

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
