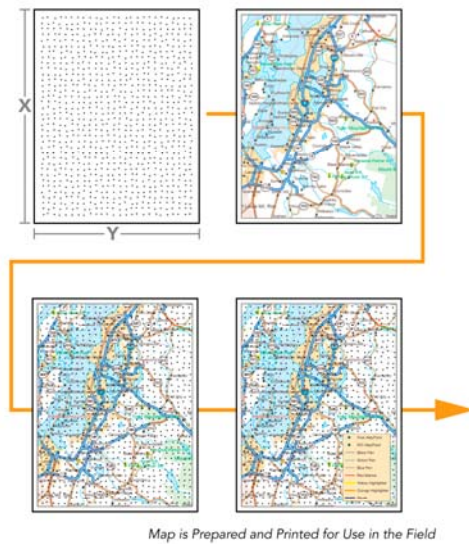

- Create and place the legend you want to use on the map you have selected

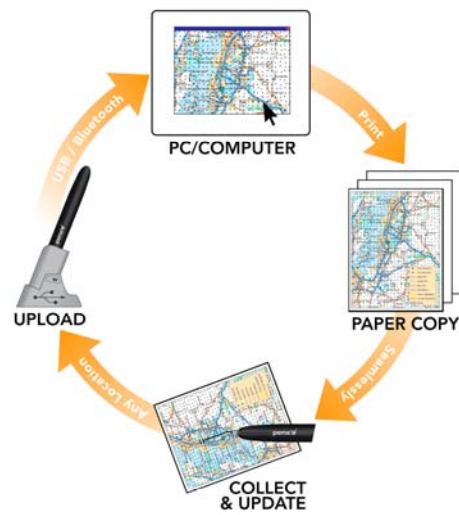

Key Features

Printing. Any ArcMap™ software-designed map can be printed on ordinary paper using many color printers* on sizes ranging from 8 1/2 x 11 to large-format A0 plots.

Action Palettes. Capturx creates virtual toolbars on printed maps as legends that list the feature layers. Teams can select a feature from the printed legend, such as a road type or pipeline, and draw it on the map with the digital pen. When the digital pen docks with the PC, the data, including the classification of those features, automatically gets synced with the geodatabase.

Adding Geodatabase Items. Any geodatabase item, from points to polylines and polygons, can be created and captured using the digital pen.

Collecting Feature Class Data. Feature class data from ArcMap can also be placed in the legend with predefined attribute values, making feature class data collection much more efficient.

Redlining. Any type of freehand text or drawing can be written on printed maps and displayed as a redline layer on the geodatabase.

Reviewing. Field data is uploaded into ArcGIS Desktop as an edit session, enabling analysts to review each new feature, make edits or corrections, and update the geodatabase.

Team Collaboration. Multiple team members can simultaneously collect GIS data using individual pens and maps. Capturx tracks data by user, enabling easy uploading, consolidation, and management of team data.

User's Guide

About the digital pen

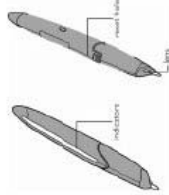
The Anoto Digital Pen DP-201 captures your pen strokes as you write or draw on a paper. Any paper product can be used as long as it has the unique Anoto dot pattern printed on it. Such a paper always has the Anoto functionality statement printed on it, reading "Paper enabling Anoto functionality" or similar.

The information captured by the digital pen can easily be transferred from the pen to, for example, a mobile phone or a PC. It can be transferred via Bluetooth to the device, or by docking the pen in the cradle connected to a PC.

Whenever you write or draw with the digital pen is saved in the digital pen memory until you transfer it. (There are also some data that are not saved and are transferred from the digital pen via Bluetooth; the information is then not saved in the pen.)

Using Bluetooth for transferring of the information from the digital pen requires pairing for the digital pen to be able to communicate with the device (see section below). Using docking requires that the Anoto pen/vector is installed on the PC.

Charging the digital pen battery

The battery is fully charged by default in the docking cradle that is connected to a USB port on a working PC. The battery may be recharged at the time of purchase; it should be fully charged before use.

Dock the digital pen in the cradle. Charging will start, and the battery indicator on the digital pen operation display will blink. The battery indicator will stop blinking if the battery is fully charged. If the battery indicator is still not lit after 20 minutes, reset the digital pen (see section below) and start charging again. It will take approximately 2.5 hours to completely charge the battery.

Pairing the digital pen with a device

When you want to send data from the digital pen via Bluetooth to a device, the digital pen must be able to communicate with the device. When you pair your digital pen with your device, you make this communication possible.

You pair your digital pen once. The digital pen remains paired when you turn it off. You can initiate the pairing in two different ways from the digital pen or from the device. To initiate pairing from the device, see the user's guide for the device. To initiate pairing from the digital pen, do as follows:

1. Make sure Bluetooth is activated on your device (see user's guide).
2. Tick the pairing box on the card that comes with the digital pen in the box. When the digital pen has detected the device, a pairing dialog opens on the device.
3. Type the PIN code that comes on a sticker with the digital pen.
4. When the digital pen buzzes three times the pairing is ready.

Turning the digital pen on/off

- Remove the cap to turn on the digital pen. Wait for the digital pen to vibrate once and the indicator to turn green. The digital pen is now ready to use.
- Put the cap back on the digital pen to turn it off. To save power and to protect the lens from dust, always keep the cap on when not using the digital pen.

Writing and drawing

When writing, a steady green indicator on the digital pen indicates that the digital pen is registering the strokes. Vibration when writing indicates problems.

- Write and draw on the area with pattern on the paper; avoid writing too near the edges (7 millimeters).
- Hold the digital pen with the lens facing the paper.
- Do not block the lens when writing.

Adapx's exclusive obligations with respect to nonconforming Hardware shall be, at Adapx's option, to repair or replace such Hardware, if it is determined to be defective, or to refund to User the purchase price paid for the Product. THE FOREGOING IS USER'S SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY AND ADAPX'S ONLY OBLIGATION WITH RESPECT TO A BREACH OF WARRANTY BY ADAPX WITH RESPECT TO THE HARDWARE.

c. The warranties set forth above shall not apply to (i) any Anoto Components (as defined in Section 10) contained in the Licensed Software or Hardware or (ii) any Licensed Software or Hardware that (x) has been modified, repaired or altered, except by or as authorized by Adapx, (y) has not been maintained in accordance with any handling or operating instructions supplied by Adapx, or (z) has been subjected to unusual physical or electrical stress, misuse, abuse, negligence or accidents.

d. EXCEPT FOR THE LIMITED WARRANTIES SET FORTH ABOVE IN THIS SECTION 8, ADAPX AND ITS SUPPLIERS DISCLAIM ALL WARRANTIES AND CONDITIONS, EXPRESS, IMPLIED OR STATUTORY ARISING FROM OR RELATED TO THE LICENSED MATERIALS AND/OR HARDWARE, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, OR NON-INFRINGEMENT OR ARISING FROM A COURSE OF DEALING, USAGE, OR TRADE PRACTICE. ADAPX DOES NOT PROMISE THAT THE LICENSED MATERIALS OR HARDWARE ARE ERROR-FREE OR WILL OPERATE WITHOUT INTERRUPTION OR MEET ALL OF USER'S REQUIREMENTS. USER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT USER HAS RELIED ON NO WARRANTIES OTHER THAN THE EXPRESS WARRANTIES IN THIS AGREEMENT. Some jurisdictions do not permit the disclaimer of certain implied warranties, so some of the foregoing disclaimers may be inapplicable. To the extent that Adapx may not as a matter of applicable law disclaim any implied warranty, the scope and duration of such warranty shall be the minimum permitted pursuant to such law.

9. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.

a. IN NO EVENT WILL ADAPX OR ITS AFFILIATES OR SUPPLIERS BE LIABLE FOR ANY LOSS OF USE, INTERRUPTION OF BUSINESS, LOST PROFITS OR LOST DATA, OR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND, REGARDLESS OF THE FORM OF ACTION, WHETHER IN CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), STRICT LIABILITY OR OTHERWISE, EVEN IF ADAPX OR ITS AFFILIATE OR SUPPLIER HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGE, AND WHETHER OR NOT ANY REMEDY PROVIDED SHOULD FAIL OF ITS ESSENTIAL PURPOSE. THE TOTAL CUMULATIVE LIABILITY TO USER, FROM ALL CAUSES OF ACTION AND ALL THEORIES OF LIABILITY, WILL BE LIMITED TO THE PURCHASE PRICE OF THE LICENSED MATERIALS PAID BY USER. USER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE AMOUNT PAID FOR THE LICENSED MATERIALS REFLECTS THIS ALLOCATION OF RISK.

b. ADAPX SHALL HAVE NO LIABILITY, NOR PAY ANY FEES, FINES, OR OTHER COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH USER'S COMPLIANCE WITH ANY NATIONAL OR LOCAL LAW OR REGULATION.

10. ANOTO COMPONENTS. Certain components provided in or with the Licensed Software are licensed from Anoto AB ("Anoto Components"). User's use of the Anoto Components is subject to and governed by the following terms and conditions in addition to those applicable to the Licensed Materials generally. Anoto is an intended third-party beneficiary of this Agreement and is entitled to enforce its provisions directly against User in its own name. ANOTO MAKES NO WARRANTIES TO THE USER, EXPRESS, IMPLIED OR STATUTORY, REGARDING THE ANOTO COMPONENTS, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, OR THEIR EQUIVALENT UNDER THE LAWS OF ANY JURISDICTION. ANOTO AND ITS LICENSORS SHALL NOT BE LIABLE TO USER FOR ANY GENERAL, SPECIAL, DIRECT, INDIRECT, CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL OR OTHER DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF THE USE OF OR INABILITY TO USE THE ANOTO COMPONENTS, HOWEVER CAUSED AND REGARDLESS OF THE THEORY OF LIABILITY, EVEN IF ANOTO HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.

11. GENERAL. The provisions of the Agreement are severable and if any one or more of the provisions hereof are illegal or otherwise unenforceable, in whole or in part, the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall nevertheless be binding on and enforceable by and between the parties hereto. Adapx's waiver of any right shall not constitute waiver of that right in future. This Agreement (including the documents it incorporates) constitutes the entire understanding between the parties with



respect to the subject matter hereof, and all prior agreements, representations, statements and undertakings, oral or written, are hereby expressly superseded and canceled. The rights and obligations of the parties to this Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington, U.S.A., excluding the UN Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods and that body of law known as conflicts of laws. Any dispute in connection with the Licensed Materials will be resolved in state or federal courts located in King County, Washington, U.S.A. User consents to the personal jurisdiction of and waives any objections to venue in such courts.
